Appoint Peter Gould as Sole Assessor to the Town of Schodack effective October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2019.

Authorize Town Clerk to publish notice of hearing to seek input on Proposed Local Law Number 1 of the Laws of 2013 to amend Chapter 197, Article III of the Code of the Town of Schodack to provide for an exemption from real property taxes for real property owned by Gold Star Parents whose child died in the line of duty while serving in the United States Armed Forces during a period of war. Said hearing is to be held on Thursday, October 10, 2013 at 7:15 p.m. at the Schodack Town Hall, 265 Schuurman Road.

Waive the requirement pursuant to Chapter 177 §1 of the Code of the Town of Schodack to hold Water Rate hearings on or before October 20th each year, in order to schedule said hearings at a special meeting at a later date to be determined.

WHEREAS, after due publication of the notice, the Town, on September 24, 2013, received (3) bids for the culvert replacement on Kraft Road as follows: a bid from Wm. J. Keller & Sons, Construction Corp. for \$142,880.00; a bid from Trinity Construction, Inc. for \$157,653.00; and a bid from James H. Maloy, Inc. for \$221,000.00

WHEREAS, the bids were reviewed for conformance to specifications and submittal of required bid bond and non-collusive certificates; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that pursuant to the recommendation of the Highway Superintendent, that the Town Board does hereby award the bid to Wm. J. Keller & Sons, Construction Corp. for its bid in the sum of \$142,880.00.
