WHEREAS, the order set March 28, 2013 at 7:05 p.m. at the Schodack Town Hall, 265 Schuurman Road, Castleton-on-Hudson, New York 12033 as the date, time and place of the public hearing to consider the map, plan and report, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, and to take such action as required and authorized by law; and,

WHEREAS, such order was published and posted as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing on the matter was held by the Town Board on the 28th day of March, 2013, beginning at 7:05 p.m. and the matter being duly discussed and all interested persons having been duly heard; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board did at that time resolve and determine to conclude and close the public hearing and to render a decision at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Town Board to be conducted on the 28th day of March, 2013 at the Schodack Town Hall.

- 1. (a) That the petition is signed and acknowledged or proved as required by law and complies with the requirements of Town Law Section 191 as to sufficiency of signers and is otherwise sufficient, and the notice of hearing was published and posted as required by law, and is otherwise sufficient;
- 2. (b) That all property and property owners within the proposed district are benefited thereby;
- 3. (c) That all the property and property owners benefited are included within the limits of the proposed district;

- 4. (d) That it is in the public interest to establish Sewer District No. 6, Extension No. 1 (Dunkin Donuts).;
- 5. (e) A hook-up fee to the property line equals \$41,000.00 and the first year cost for full operation for the typical property within Sewer District No. 6, Extension No. 1 (Dunkin Donuts) is \$28,400.00;
- 6. (f) Approval of the New York State Comptroller is not required for the formation of Sewer District No. 6, Extension No. 1 (Dunkin Donuts). There is no public debt repayment for the first year cost associated with the creation of Sewer District No. 6, Extension No. 1 (Dunkin Donuts), and that the benefited property is not a typical property or a typical one or two family home; and it is further,

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, that the establishment of Sewer District No. 6, Extension No. 1 (Dunkin Donuts), as set forth in the map, plan and report, be approved and that the approval of the Comptroller of the State of New York is not required for the reasons set forth above, and that the requested improvements be constructed, and the necessary easements and lands be acquired upon the required funds being made available and provided for, and such district shall be known and designated as Sewer District No. 6, Extension No. 1 (Dunkin Donuts) in the Town of Schodack, and shall be bounded and described as set forth on Schedule "A" attached hereto; and it is further,

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Schodack shall, within ten (10) days after the adoption of this Resolution, file a certified copy thereof, in the Office of the State Department of Audit and Control at Albany, New York, and in the office of the Rensselaer County Clerk; and it is further,

RESOLVED AND DETERMINED, that the maximum amount to be expended for said improvement and/or acquisition of necessary lands is the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand (\$1,300,000.00) Dollars.

- 2. The facts and conclusions set forth in the written Negative Declaration attached hereto are derived from the full EAF, reports, submittals and other relevant information, including the personal knowledge and familiarity of the Town Board with the project site and its surrounding areas.

- 3. The Town Board hereby declares and adopts the written Negative Declaration attached hereto.
- 4. 4. Based upon the Negative Declaration, the Town of Schodack Town Board hereby declares that the project will have no significant adverse environmental impact, and hereby issues a Negative Declaration under SEORA.
- 5. The Negative Declaration (copy attached) and a copy of this resolution shall be filed in the Office of the Town Clerk.
- 6. The Negative Declaration and a copy of this resolution shall be made available for inspection and copying by the public.
