Supervisor Dowds called the January 9, 2014 Organizational Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and dispensed with roll call. All present as noted above.

Departmental Reports

The following monthly departmental reports were read and/or posted and filed in the Office of the Town Clerk: Town Clerk, Building Department and Police.

Assessor's Report

Peter Goold, Assessor, addressed the Board relative to resolution [2014-66]. He explained that he has been working with Municipal Assessment Services (MAS), headed by John Bonanno, regarding an assessment improvement project. The focus of this project is to update our assessment roll and bring it in line with current market value. After reviewing our data, MAS offered three options to update our roll. They are:

- 1) Full recollection of all current property data approximate cost \$600,000.00+
- 2) Field verification of current property data approximate cost \$470,000.00
- 3) *Utilize a statistical method called "trending" approximate cost \$34,000.00 (@\$5.50/parcel)

Since our current assessment roll is reasonably correct and current, MAS recommended Option 3. This project would include analysis of residential sales and assessments, developing trends for partials grouped by value, update of the values and identification of "outliers" (i.e. properties that are way beyond the mid-range properties and why that is so), production of change of assessment notices with the recommendation that only those properties increased will receive a notice and to conduct informal meetings with citizens

regarding the change recommendation. Mr. Goold said MAS has an extensive background in assessment review and he was comfortable with going with their recommendation for Option 3 which is the most economical and should be the best approach for our town.

Public Comment

K. Stokem asked for more detail about Option 1 and Option 2. Mr. Goold explained that Option 1 would mirror what was done in 2007 (full re-evaluation) and they don't feel that is warranted at this time, since we have data collectors go out throughout the year to keep the files updated. Option 2 would be to do a statistical sampling and reverify a certain number of parcels in the field. MAS did a small amount of statistical sampling and compared it to our data and they feel our data, while not perfect, is definitely accurate enough to support the trending option, which is far less costly. Mr. Stokem asked if other municipalities use trending to bring assessments to current levels. Mr. Bonanno said ves. He has worked with several local municipalities and he knew of some other consultants that offer the same service. The Supervisor said that trending is a tried and true statistical technique that has wide acceptance, in this field and others. Mr. Stokem felt if it would help protect our investment that was made in 2007, it was worth it. Councilmen Bult and Curtis said the Board has been reviewing this for some time and feels that this builds on the 2007 assessment and will bring our assessments in line with current market values. R. Lemka asked if public meetings were included in the contract. Mr. Bonanno responded that citizens always have the right to discuss the information and methodology used to determine the assessment of your property with the Assessor prior to the formalization of the roll. One of the reasons a trending project is so much less expensive is because you do not have to do some of the legwork and interaction with the public required by the other options. If the Board decides that they want to do that, it will be much more costly. Further, due to the real estate market flattening and dropping in areas we will probably see lower assessments. Mr. Lemka asked if a letter will be sent out if the assessment goes down. Mr. Bonanno said no; that is only required when an assessment increases. Mr. Lemka expressed concern about the grievance process and also asked about the project duration. The Supervisor said none of the regular grievance process changes. Mr. Goold said the project will take approximately 6 months and explained the analytical process which culminates in the production of a set of values. A. Gruenberg asked if it would be completed by this year's taxable status date. Mr. Bonanno said the Tentative Assessment Roll will be in place by the May 1st deadline and anyone who has an increase in their assessment will receive a written notification. May 1st is also the beginning of the normal grievance process when residents can begin to build their case to go to the Board of Assessment Review (BAR) which begins on 4th Tuesday in May. A brief discussion of the grievance process ensued. Mr. Lemka felt the people involved in this project should be local and familiar with the Town and that the general mindset of the BAR should be reevaluated to be more equitable to the residents.

Announcements

S. Dowds welcomed his assistant, Dawne Kelly, back to work after a month's absence and thanked the Town Clerk and other departments for helping out during her absence.

Briefing of Resolution Agenda

With respect to resolution [2014-32], S. Dowds offered the name of James D. Shaughnessy to fill the vacancy on the Planning Board. He noted that Mr. Shaughnessy is a P.E. with a Master's degree in civil engineering and gave a brief overview of his credentials. Given his extensive background he felt that Mr. Shaughnessy would be a good asset to the Planning Board. Resolution [2014-54] is to simplify multiple addenda for Laberge Engineering. Resolution [2014-67] is the map, plan and report for Extension No. 3 for Consolidated Water District 101, which is described in [2014-68]. He said this is essentially a clean-up of outstanding issues in that area. All other resolutions are self-explanatory.

Board Discussion on Resolutions

C. Curtis said he realized that the Board has been considering the Planning Board appointment for a while, but asked the Board's indulgence to postpone the appointment tonight. He explained that he has been very busy working with Mr. Goold regarding the MAS contract and hasn't had sufficient time to review all the resumes received in detail. Further, as they sent over a period of time, he wasn't sure he even had all of them. He also thought it would be nice to meet the individual prior to appointment as they normally do. The Supervisor stated that all resumes had been sent to the members. Board members supported C. Curtis and would like to make sure they have all the resumes, review them and possibly meet some of the candidates. C. Kenney said he would like the appointment to be on the next agenda.

With respect to resolution [2014-38], C. Bult felt the dollar amount was too high given the broad spectrum of services that could be offered. He would like to drop that number to \$5,000.00. Then the Board has a better understanding of what projects the money is being spent on before the cap is reached. The Supervisor thought that \$5,000.00 was not a realistic number and suggested \$10,000.00. Following a brief discussion, with all members offering their input, the consensus was to amend resolution [2014-038] to \$7,500.00.

Public Comment on Board Resolutions

J. Jensis asked if the appointees were town residents. The Supervisor said yes, for those offices to which residency is applicable.

- R. Lemka asked if the town gets a financial statement from the libraries. The Supervisor said all libraries submit quarterly reports.
- K. Stokem asked for an explanation of resolution [2014-01], the supervisor said it is a surety bond for all employees who handle money. Mr. Stokem spoke on the inconsistency of having Planning/Zoning minutes posted on the town's website. He also felt the Town Board agendas should be posted sooner than they are. Mr. Stokem felt that Mr. Lavoie didn't seem to be actively engaged in the Planning Board discussion and wondered why he was reappointed to the Planning Board. The Supervisor said he has a background in construction and brings a lot of knowledge to the table. It was Mr. Stokem's opinion that the Planning Board is better served by having members that are strong advocates. He asked why monetary caps were not on certain consulting contracts, but were on others. The Supervisor explained that usually it is based on the type of service offered; those that have we some degree of control over are normally capped, and the others are not (i.e. certioraris, technology, etc.). Regardless, all of them have a budgeted amount and if that is exceeded it would have to come before the Board for a budget amendment.
- C. Curtis stated the county designated the *Times Union* as well as the *Record* because the *Record* is no longer printed in Rensselaer County. The Town Clerk said when this was researched before she found that per line charge for a legal notice is based on circulation, so the cost to publish in the *Times Union* is more costly. A. Gruenberg added that he believes the *Record* is still considered as being published in Rensselaer County which is one of the criteria for designation.

Ken Stokem asked for clarification about the Water District 101 extension. The Supervisor explained that this extension is for those people in the designated area that want water or who could potentially benefit from it but are not paying capital costs at this time. It is essentially cleaning up the records and may require some physical work for certain parcels.
