D.S. Curtis called the September 11, 2014 meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and dispensed with roll call. All present as noted above. He then called for a moment of silence in remembrance of those who died in the terrorist attack on the United States on September 11, 2001.

#### **Departmental Reports**

The following monthly departmental reports were read and/or posted and filed in the Office of the Town Clerk: Town Clerk, Building Department, Assessor, Historian and Planning & Zoning.

#### **Board Review of Claims/Transfers/Amendments**

The Board reviewed claims #14-1380 to 14-1507 on Abstract No. 2014-09 which includes all funds and claims to be paid and those paid since the previous town board meeting.

#### Briefing of Resolution Agenda

C. Curtis explained that resolution [2014-196] was relative to the settlement of a grievance for the highway department. Resolution [2014-205] pertains to the Sewer Line for Dunkin' Donuts. The bonding/borrowing was done for one million dollars but the project actually came in at one million thirty thousand dollars so this amends the escrow agreement to reflect the actual costs. He noted that none of these costs were borne by the taxpayers. All costs were borne by Dunkin' Donuts. With regard to resolution [2014-206], C. Curtis explained that when Mr. DeFruscio was initially hired he was part-time and his hourly rate was \$20.00/hr. He is now full-time and fulfilling the duties of Building Inspector and Code Enforcement so the Board is increasing his compensation. All other resolutions are self-explanatory.

#### Public Comment

F. Graziano asked if Mr. DeFruscio was assuming the title of Building Inspector. C.

Curtis said currently, his title will remain as is and the Board is waiting for some clarification from civil service. C. Bult said the position of Building Inspector is still open at this point, but Mr. DeFruscio is assuming all those duties.

M. Sherwood asked for further information on resolution [2014-202]. The Comptroller said the fiscal advisors assist with debt borrowing. One of the requirements when we borrow money is a continuing disclosure requirement for SEC. They assist us in meeting that obligation. The fee is \$2,000.00/annually.

M. Sherwood said the town has posted for a Human Resource Manager (HR) and asked if that meant that would not be contracting with the consultant. C. Curtis said the Board is not sure at this time. An HR consultant is a great resource for management, but the Board has decided that they would like an in-house person, even if it is only part-time. At this time, there is no intention of having a contract. Ms. Sherwood asked if that was a civil service title. C. Curtis said yes. Ms. Sherwood suggested that if they don't get someone from within Schodack, the Board waive the residency requirement because she strongly believes that there are many excellent HR people in the area.
