SCHODACK CODE

SECTION: 219-27. FENCES AND WALLS

- A. Fences and walls shall not exceed eight (8) feet in height when erected in side or rear yards nor three (3) feet in height when erected within twenty-five (25) feet of the front lot line or highway right-of-way, except agriculture fencing which may be five (5) feet.
- B. All such fences and walls shall conform to the requirements of 219-19 as pertains to corner lots.
- C. Section 219-19 At all street intersections, no obstructions to vision, such as a fence, wall, hedge, structure or planting over three (3) feet in height, shall be erected on any lot within the triangle formed by the intersecting street lines, or their projections where corners are rounded, and a straight line joining said street lines at points which are forty (40) feet distant from their point of intersection measured along said street lines and/or projections.
- D. All such fences and walls shall be measured from the ground level at the base of the fence or wall, except that if such in a retaining wall, the height shall be measured from the average of the ground level at each end of said retaining wall.
