Sealed bids for the above noted project were received on March 2, 2023. These bids have been carefully checked for accuracy and tabulations of same are enclosed herewith.

- The low Base Bid (PVC) is that of American Evergreen, Inc.
- The low Alternate Base Bid (HDPE) is also American Evergreen, Inc.
- The low Base Bid less Deductible Alternate No. 1 is that of American Evergreen, Inc.
- The low Alternate Base Bid less Deductible Alternate No. 1 is also American Evergreen, Inc.

We find the stated qualifications of the American Evergreen, Inc. to be satisfactory.

It is, therefore our recommendation that the Contract be awarded to American Evergreen, Inc. for the Base Bid (PVC) in the amount of \$2,237,210.00 at the April 13th Town Board meeting. A suggested resolution is enclosed for the Board's consideration and use in awarding this project.

It should be noted that this Contract is on a unit price basis. As such, the final contract cost will increase or decrease, depending upon the actual quantities required by the exigencies of construction.

The construction is to be funded from the following sources:

- a) NYWIIA grant (NYS grant contract pending);
- b) CDBG grant;
- c) Funds from the County-Town agreement for the Rt 9 Water South project; and
- d) Long Term Debt.

Sealed bids for the above noted project were received on March 9, 2023. The two bids received have been carefully checked for accuracy and tabulations of same are enclosed herewith.

There was an informality in the bids received. William J. Keller & Sons Construction Corporation ("Keller") bid a steel structure with aluminum wingwalls and headwalls. Keller placed their amount bid in the "Base Bid" (all aluminum) portion of the form. In doing so they crossed out "aluminum" and typed in "**Steel" next to the description and made the following footnote to the form "**This size structure is not available in Aluminum, Bid based on Galv.Steel and Aluminum Wingwalls/Headwalls". A copy of the Keller bid form as submitted is attached. We have confirmed their bid to be for steel structure with aluminum wing walls and headwalls (see attached letter from Keller).

No bids were received for an all-aluminum "Base Bid", and the bid received for Deductible Alternate No. 1 (all steel) was higher than the hybrid proposed by Keller. We find that the hybrid structure is a better structure than the all-aluminum structure. Therefore, it is our recommendation that the Town waive this informality as allowed in the bid documents and the contract be awarded to Keller for the hybrid structure in the amount of \$1,082,280.10 at the April 13th Town Board meeting.

A suggested resolution is enclosed for the Board's consideration and use in awarding this project.






