Dear Schodack Town Board,

We, the members of the Castleton Volunteer Ambulance Service, would like to request an increase in the contribution made to our Service Award. Back in January, 1999 the Town of Schodack established a NYS Comptroller administered Service Award Program for members of the Castleton Volunteer Ambulance. Currently, a \$700 contribution is made to the program account of a participating volunteer for each year a volunteer earns 50 points for participating in ambulance activities. The program must comply with the NYS General Municipal Law (GML). The GML was amended in the fall of 2019 to allow the local government sponsor(s) of a program to increase the annual contribution to as much as \$1,200. Such an increase is subject to mandatory referendum (i.e. the proposed increase must be approved at an election of residents of the ambulance district).

During 2020, 21 volunteers earned 50 points. The Town cost for 2020 was \$14,700. Had the annual contribution been \$1,200, the cost would be \$25,200 or \$10,500 greater. We expect 25 volunteers, at most, to be eligible for the 2021 year.

Our volunteer ambulance service is asking our town residents to approve this proposed increase to help retain and hopefully recruit more active volunteers so we can continue to provide high quality care to our residents of Schodack.

AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to the maximum contribution for certain service award programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (b) of section 218 of the general municipal law, as amended by chapter 452 of the laws of 2004, is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (b) The sponsor of a defined contribution plan shall contribute to the plan a fixed amount of money, as determined by the sponsor, on behalf of each participant who is credited with a year of service. The minimum and maximum contribution requirements for a defined contribution service award program shall be as follows. The minimum contribution shall be one hundred twenty dollars per year of service. The maximum contribution shall be [seven] twelve hundred dollars per year of service. The maximum number of years of service for which a participant may receive a contribution shall be forty years. The sponsor shall appropriate annually an amount sufficient to pay the contributions.
- 14 § 2. Subdivision 1 of section 219-f of the general municipal law, as 15 amended by chapter 452 of the laws of 2004, is amended to read as 16 follows:
- 1. The sponsor of a service award program shall contribute to the program a fixed amount of money, as determined by the sponsor, on behalf of each participant who is credited with a year of ambulance service. The minimum contribution shall be one hundred twenty dollars per year of ambulance service. The maximum contribution shall be [seven] twelve hundred dollars per year of ambulance service.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, any change or amendment to a service award program made by this act shall only take effect as of the first of January next succeeding completion of the proceedings required for adoption of such change or amendment and shall only apply prospectively.

**BILL NUMBER: S4207A** 

**SPONSOR: METZGER** 

TITLE OF BILL: An act to amend the general municipal law, in relation to the maximum contribution for certain service award programs

#### **PURPOSE:**

To increase from seven hundred dollars, to twelve hundred dollars, the maximum contribution that may be made per year of service to a defined contribution plan service award for volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance squad members.

#### **SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:**

Section 1: Amends subdivision (b) of section 218 of the General Municipal Law to increase from seven hundred dollars, to twelve hundred dollars, the maximum contribution that may be made per year of service to a defined contribution plan service award for volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance squad members.

Section 2: Effective date.

#### **JUSTIFICATION:**

Section 218 of the General Municipal Law which provides for the defined contribution plan service award for volunteer firefighters and ambulance squad members was enacted as Chapter 775 of 1988. Since that time the maximum award allowed has not kept up with inflation and has been increased only once, in 2004, from \$480 per year to the current cap of \$700 per year. It is becoming more and more difficult to recruit volunteer firefighters and ambularice squad members, by increasing the maximum allowed to be awarded under the defined contribution plan, this will make it easier to attract individuals to become volunteers.
