**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Schodack (hereinafter "Town Board") as the anticipated recipient of the grant award is required to designate a Certifying Officer for the purpose of signing required documents pertaining to this grant; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board does hereby designate Supervisor David B. Harris as the Town's Certifying Officer for the purpose of signing required documents pertaining to this anticipated grant (CFA #104754).

- **2021-089)** Approve the list of Volunteer Ambulance Workers Service Award Program Participants for all 2020 active Volunteer Ambulance Workers of the Castleton Volunteer Ambulance Service Inc., as submitted.
- **2021-090)** Ratify and affirm authorizing acceptance of Proposal date 5/7/2020 with Lexipol for Annual Subscription of Law Enforcement Policy Manual and Daily Training Bulletins for the period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$7,665.00.
- **2021-091)** Authorize Supervisor Harris to execute and administer Quit Claim deed in accordance with Section 212-a in the Highway Law for abandoned paper road relative to Old McClellan Road to James Tucker Mayo an Carolyn Lee Pincus further described in metes and bounds descriptions dated November 10, 2020. Further authorize Supervisor Harris to execute and administer TP 584 and RP-5217 in conjunction with Quit Claim Deed transfer.
- **2021-092)** Pursuant to Article 7 Section 140 of the Highway Law, the Highway Superintendent hereby appoints Steven Rivers, subject to final approval by the Rensselaer County Civil Service Commission, as an Operator 2, at an hourly rate as set forth in the Year 2021 adopted budget. Said appointment is effective as of February 16, 2021.
- **2021-093)** All Civil Service requirements having been met for the position of Police Officer, the Town hereby appoints Wally Lodin to the position of full-time Police Officer effective February 12, 2021 at 2<sup>nd</sup> year level salary as set forth in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Town of Schodack and Schodack Police Department, United Public Service Employees Union (UPSEU) dated January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2023.

- **2021-094)** Ratify and affirm to authorize the Town Clerk to execute and administer a contract with New York Industries for the Disabled (NYSID) for a partnership price concurrence agreement with Image Data for document scanning services for building permit large format plans at \$2.29 per image at a cost not to exceed \$2,519.00. Project cost is budgeted in Records Management budget. Project was approved by Town Board September 26, 2019, completed in 2020, originally billed by NYSID in 2020 and should be payable from 2020 funds.
- **2021-095)** WHEREAS, pursuant to the franchise agreement between Time Warner Cable ("TWC") (now known as Charter Communications) and the Town of Schodack, TWC/Charter pays the Town a fee for a special franchise to operate its cable television business in the public right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, for the year 2020 TWC/Charter paid the Town of Schodack \$95,550.91 in franchise fees, and

WHEREAS, TWC/Charter was levied a total of \$4,149.17 in Town taxes on five special franchise properties, and

WHEREAS, Section 626(1) of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York provides that the amount paid as a franchise fee is to be deducted from the taxes levied on a special franchise, and

WHEREAS, Section 626(2) of the Real Property Tax Law provides that the person responsible for collecting the franchise fee shall deliver to the Town of Schodack a certificate showing the amount of the franchise fee paid for the year ending on the date set forth in the certificate, and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the certificate, the law requires the Town of Schodack to enter a credit on the tax roll in the amount shown on the certificate, and

WHEREAS, Rensselaer County Bureau of Finance is responsible for entering the credit on the tax roll, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 626, the TWC/Charter Tax Department returned the Town's Special Franchise tax bill, and

WHEREAS, TWC/Charter is required to make a request in order to receive a credit on the tax roll, and

WHEREAS, the Town has received a request for the credit on property taxes assessed in 2019 from the franchise fees paid during 2020,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED to authorize payment of \$4,149.17 to Rensselaer County Bureau of Finance based on the 2020 TWC/Charter Utility report on said franchise properties assessed within the Town of Schodack.

- **2021-096)** Authorize Supervisor Harris to execute and administer an annual maintenance agreement, including parts and labor, with Eastern Copy Products, LLC for the Konica Minolta Bizhub 654a copier on the third floor at the Town Hall, ID # 770GF, for the period February 2, 2021 to February 1, 2022 for \$1058.40 annually. Contract includes 168,000 copies annually with an overage charge of \$0.00696 per copy.
- **2021-097)** Authorize Supervisor Harris to execute and administer an annual maintenance agreement, including parts and labor, with Eastern Copy Products, LLC for both the Konica Minolta Bizhub 284E copier in the Town Clerk's office, ID#731FL and for the Muratec MFX 3530 printer for Justice Court, ID#227FN, combined contract, for the period February 24, 2021 to February 23, 2022 for \$536.06 annually. Contract includes 30,660 copies annually with an overage charge of \$0.01752 per copy.
- **2021-098)** Concur that the Planning Board be designated lead agency for the Green Dale Community Solar County Route 32 project.
- **2021-099)** Ratify and affirm authorization the appropriation of the General Fund Capital Reserve Balance in the amount of \$82,703.91 as follows:

Garland & Co repair to the Town Hall Roof Res 2020-315, not to exceed \$179,978

- **2021-0100)** Authorize the transfer of inter-fund loan balance of \$10,000 from Castleton Water District #7 to the General Fund.
- **2021-0101)** Authorize the appropriation of General Fund Capital Reserves in an amount not to exceed \$97,274.09 as follows:

Garland & Co repair to the Town Hall Roof Res 2020-315, not to exceed \$97,274.09 of the total proposed total \$179,978.

- **2021-0102)** Authorize the Comptroller's recommendation to direct the Town Supervisor to pay the claims #21-0113 to 21-0303 on Abstract No. 2021-02, in the amount of \$2,199,117.85, including the claims paid (\$188,443.23) since the previous town board meeting.
- **2021-0103)** Authorize the January 2021budget modifications, interfund loans and interfund transfers as provided in document dated February 2021 and recommended by the Comptroller.
