2017-139) WHEREAS, Sheila Golden, Director of Youth and Recreation, has recommended that the Summer Swim Program take place at the Sidney Albert Albany Jewish Community Center (SAAJCC) in Albany and stated the advantages of using this pool facility,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board approves the use of the pool at the Sidney Albert Albany Jewish Community Center (SAAJCC) for the summer camp program, subject to review as to form by the Attorney to the Town, and
