RESTRICTIONS ON BUSINESS

- 1. Not engage in such business at any time between the hours of 8:30 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.
- 2. Willfully misstate any fact relating to merchandise or services offered for sale.
- 3. Willfully offer for sale any article of an unwholesome or defective nature.
- 4. Call attention to himself or his vending activity by creating a public disturbance.
- 5. Willfully and for the purpose of vending, enter upon premises clearly displaying a sign prohibiting solicitation.
- 6. Fail to promptly leave premises upon request of any occupant of such premises.
- 7. No undue traffic congestion or hazard, both vehicular and pedestrian, will be created.
- 8. That the use or operation shall not impede or inconvenience the public.

Every licensee, while exercising his license, shall carry the license with him or her and shall exhibit the same upon demand to any police officer or citizen.

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) or to imprisonment for a term not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or both. In lieu of, or in addition to, any fine or imprisonment or both imposed hereunder each such offense may be punishable by a civil penalty not to exceed \$250.00 to be recovered in an action or proceeding in a court of competent jurisdiction. For each day such offense or violation continues, the violator shall be subject to a separate civil penalty.
