# REQUEST FOR LWRP COMMITTEE VOLUNTEERS

The Town of Schodack is seeking volunteers to serve on a Waterfront Advisory Committee which will be reviewing and updating the Local Waterfront Revitalization Program. This program was adopted by the Town of Schodack in 1991 and the Village of Castleton in 1993, but now needs to be updated. The waterfront area is approximately eight miles long along the easterly side of the Hudson River, predominantly undeveloped, and separated from the waterfront by the Amtrak rail line. As set forth in Schodack's local law endorsing this program, the Town hoped that "the preservation, and enhancement and utilization of the natural and man-made resources of the coastal area take place in a coordinated and comprehensive manner to ensure a proper balance between natural resources and the need to accommodate population growth and economic development."

The committee will be made up of four representatives designated by the Schodack Town Board who live in Schodack outside of the Village of Castleton, four representatives appointed by the Castleton Village Board who live in the Village, and one chairperson appointed jointly by the Supervisor of Schodack and the Mayor of Castleton.
