Harris welcomed Mr. Herrick to the dais to have the oath of office administered by the Town Clerk. A brief pinning ceremony followed.

Public Comment

J. Visalli, a resident of Sunset Road, addressed the board regarding unsafe conditions on Sunset Road. These conditions included uneven width, three blind horizontal curves, one blind vertical curve, no shoulders, only one speed reduction sign on a sharp curve, electrical poles too close to the road, and no stripping to guide motorists. He added that the speed limit, which was 35 m.p.h., was excessive and frequently ignored by motorists. He recommended that the board consider reducing the speed limit on Sunset, upgrade the road to county standards and ask National Grid to move all utility poles from the edge of the road. He offered his expertise as an engineer to assist in the changes. S. Harris thanked Mr. Visalli and said he would contact Ken Holmes, Highway Superintendent, regarding the concerns. C. Bult noted that the board had discussed the possibility of identifying high traffic areas and beginning a stripping program at a budget workshop last year. As for reducing the speed limit, he said K. Holmes would need to contact the County to conduct a speed survey. Mr. Visalli responded that the town did not own the road as it was designated as a "user" road. He advised the board that it may be necessary to take property along side of the road to make the width uniform.

As there was no further business before the Board, C. Swartz made a motion to adjourn the 09/09/21 Town Board meeting at 7:31 p.m., seconded by C. Rex. Meeting adjourned.
